



United in Faith St. Edward & St. Michael



12 Days Pilgrimage to England, Ireland & Scotland with Fr. John-Patrick & Dcn. John

April 12 -23, 2027

Day 1 – DEPART FROM SEATTLE AIRPORT TO LONDON

DAY 2 – LONDON – ARRIVAL

Arrive in London and begin our pilgrimage in the spiritual and historic heart of England. After a rest, visit Westminster Abbey, one of the great churches of Christendom and the site of English coronations for nearly a thousand years. At the center of the Abbey, we will visit the Shrine of St. Edward the Confessor, the 11th-century king and saint whose tomb remains one of England's historic pilgrimage destinations. Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in London.



DAY 3 – LONDON / STAMFORD / YORK

Breakfast at hotel. Depart London and travel north through the English countryside. Stop in the historic market town of Stamford, known for its beautiful stone architecture and medieval churches. Continue to York, one of England's great historic Christian cities. Experience the magnificent presence of York Minster cathedral. Overnight with dinner.



DAY 4 – YORK / HOLY ISLAND OF LINDISFARNE

Breakfast at hotel. Travel north to the Holy Island of Lindisfarne, one of the most important centers of early Christianity in Britain. Accessible by its tidal causeway, Lindisfarne became a center of Celtic Christianity when St. Aidan established a monastery here in 635. It was later home to St. Cuthbert, and it became associated with the creation of the magnificent Lindisfarne Gospels. Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in Edinburgh Area.

DAY 5 – LINDISFARNE / EDINBURGH

Breakfast at hotel. Travel north across the Scottish border to Edinburgh, Scotland's historic capital. Explore the city's medieval Old Town and prominent churches. Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in Edinburgh.



DAY 6 – EDINBURGH / STIRLING / OBAN

Breakfast at hotel. Depart Edinburgh for Stirling, a city at the crossroads of Scottish history and faith. View Stirling Castle before continuing west through the dramatic scenery of the Scottish Highlands, following mountain valleys, lochs, and ancient travel routes toward Scotland's western coast. Arrive in the seaside town of Oban, gateway to the Hebridean islands. Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in Oban.

DAY 7 – OBAN / ISLE OF MULL / IONA / OBAN

Breakfast at hotel. Cross by ferry from Oban to Craignure on the Isle of Mull, then travel across Mull to Fionnphort, for the short ferry crossing to the sacred island of Iona. Visit Iona Abbey, walk in the footsteps of generations of monks and pilgrims, and experience the extraordinary quiet of the island. Return to Oban. Overnight with dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in Oban.



DAY 8 – OBAN / CARFIN

Breakfast at hotel. Continuing toward the Glasgow area. Finish in Carfin, the home of Carfin Grotto, Scotland's National Shrine to Our Lady of Lourdes and an important center of Catholic pilgrimage. Overnight, bed and breakfast at your hotel in Carfin area / Glasgow area.

DAY 9 – CARFIN / CAIRNRYAN/ BELFAST

Travel south through Scotland to Cairnryan, and from there board the ferry across the Irish Sea. Sail to Belfast, enjoying a restful crossing before arriving in Northern Ireland. Overnight, dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in **Belfast** or area.

Day 10 – BELFAST / FAUGHART / BUBLIN

Travel south from Belfast to Faughart, traditionally identified as the birthplace of St. Brigid of Ireland. Visit St. Brigid's Shrine, holy well, ancient church ruins, and sacred landscape associated with one of Ireland's three great patron saints. Continue to Dublin and visit Trinity College, home of the historic Old Library and the magnificent Book of Kells, the illuminated Gospel manuscript created by early medieval monks. The visit creates a particularly meaningful connection between our time on Iona and one of the greatest surviving treasures of that monastic tradition. Overnight, dinner, bed and breakfast at your hotel in **Dublin** or area.

DAY 11 – DUBLIN / GLENDALOUGH / KILDARE / DUBLIN

Travel into the Wicklow Mountains to Glendalough, the extraordinary monastic valley founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Explore the remains of the ancient monastic settlement, including its churches, Celtic crosses, and famous round tower amid one of Ireland's most beautiful sacred landscapes. Continue to Kildare, where St. Brigid established her influential religious community in the 5th century. Visit the places associated with Brigid's ministry and legacy, completing the pilgrimage path begun at her traditional birthplace in Faughart. Return to Dublin for our final evening together. Overnight, in **Dublin** or area.

DAY 12 – DUBLIN / SEATTLE

Transfer to Dublin Airport for our return flight to Seattle
